Dear Year 2 Parents/Guardians,

The Year 2 Swimming Carnival will be held at AIS **Tuesday, 6 May**. This event is designed to complement the Swim Scheme in which students have been participating this term. We are looking forward to allowing all our students to put their skills into practice in an atmosphere of friendly competition. The year group will compete in their Houses (Derwent, Lachlan, Fitzroy and Murray).

As we have done in the past, the year group will be split in half to ensure a safe and enjoyable carnival.

The details of the carnival are as follows:

Year 2 - Tuesday 6 May
8.40-9.40 2FO, 2DA, 2MI, 2DU, 2HB, 2FD
9:50-10.50 2BU, 2SI, 2TY, 2KE, 2WR, 2PA

Logistics: All students need to arrive at school at the normal time. Children should come to school with swimming costumes under their sport uniform (House T-shirt) to facilitate an easier change. Students should also arrive with sunscreen already applied.

Venue: AIS Swimming Pool

Supervision: Students are asked to remain seated in their allocated house areas under the shelters in front of the glass doors when not participating in an event.

Uniform: All students will need to bring their swimmers, goggles and towels. Students will need to wear their coloured House t-shirts, PE shorts and sports hat. All students must have their own sunscreen.

Extras: All students are required to bring a water bottle. Drink containers will be set up for students to refill their bottles throughout the carnival.

Events: Students will participate in all or some of the following events:

- Kickboard, Noodle, Freestyle and Backstroke races (25m). (Life jackets are available to students if required.)
- In each year group there will be an overall winning House.





Inclement weather:

Should the weather be inclement on the day of the carnival, it will be postponed to a later date. Parents will be advised via text message should a decision be made not to go ahead with the carnival.

Please note that there is very limited space and shade at the pool for spectators. Parents are responsible for supervision of accompanying siblings and are asked to remain behind the barriers at the end of the pool closest to the gate. Please do not hesitate to contact your child's class teacher if you require any further information.
