

All School Uniform Guide



1. UNIFORM POLICY

- 1.1. Students are expected to be dressed in the correct AIS uniform at all times. Wearing a uniform with pride and being neatly presented is a skill that is required in the real world by many professions and fields of work. The way we present ourselves in uniform conveys an important message of respect.
- 1.2. If a student reports to the Head of Year office in an incorrect uniform, a note must be presented by the parent. Correct uniform applies to students outside of the school when they are in the Singapore community.

2. YEAR 12 STUDENTS

- 2.1. The Year 12 Senior Jerseys can be worn as a part of the AIS Uniform; however, surnames write on the back must be the student's formal surname (no nicknames) and the jersey's design must be approved by the AIS Communications Department before orders are placed. Jerseys are not to be worn on formal school occasions, including assemblies.
- 2.2. A silver tie is to be worn by all Year 12 students to indicate their status as senior students and leaders within our school community.

3. UNIFORM SHOP

- 3.1. Correct AIS school uniform (purchased through Lim Meng Keng Department Store #02-18 Holland Road Shopping Centre, 211 Holland Avenue Singapore 278967) is to be worn to and from school. Students are required to follow the school dress code and present themselves appropriately.

4. MUFTI DRESS CODE

- 4.1. On days, students are invited to dress in particular themes to support the fundraising for our School Charity: HOME. MUFTI dress involves students having some fun to wear colourful clothing and accessories for a donation of \$2. This money is collected during STRIVE /me. It is expected that students who wear MUFTI Dress on this day will donate money as an indication of their support.
- 4.2. On MUFTI Days, students are reminded to:
 - 4.2.1. Wear clothing which reflects the theme of the MUFTI Day
 - 4.2.2. Dress appropriately for school and learning
 - 4.2.3. Wear closed in shoes
 - 4.2.4. Not wear singlets, midriff tops, short skirts or excessively short shorts • Not wear any logos or clothing which would be deemed offensive
 - 4.2.5. Bring sports uniform if required for the day

Dress	AIS celebrates and values the diversity of our community, and our uniform can be adapted to all genders, religions, and cultural dress. In consultation with AHoS alternative uniforms are available	Navy striped school dress with white collar and tie, worn at the knee
Pants	Long navy trousers, worn on or above the hips	
Shorts	Navy formal school shorts may be worn in Years 6 – 12. Must be worn on or above the knees	
Belts	Plain black leather school belt worn appropriately on the hips	
Socks	Ankle length standard white AIS school socks with Navy AIS logo to be worn with logo visible (not folded over) Ankle length standard white AIS school socks with Navy AIS logo to be worn with shorts Ankle length standard black AIS school socks with white AIS logo to be worn with navy trousers	
Shoes	Regular plain black leather school shoes must be worn. They must be clean and polished. Black runners are not permitted as school shoes.	
Ties	School tie must be worn at all times	
Hats	All students must wear a hat if playing outside and during PE lessons	
Jumper	Navy knit school jumper. Students are not permitted to wear the jumper around their waist. *	
PE	The school PE uniform is to be worn for all PE lessons. House shirts may be worn for PE lessons,	

	as advised by PE staff with AIS branded PE shorts at all school carnival events. Appropriate running shoes must be worn, not skater shoes e.g. Vans or Converse
Hair	Neat and tidy haircut Fully tied back if shoulder length due to health and safety Fringe clearly out of face, not tucked behind the ears Hair ties, headbands and clips must be navy, black or white in colour Only natural hair tones accepted No extreme hairstyles Limited use of hair product Facial hair (beard, moustache) not acceptable
Jewellery	Only the following items are permitted: Earrings are to be plain small round gold/silver studs or small round sleeper earrings (one per ear lobe). No additional plastic earrings to be worn. Watch Medical alerts No make-up or nail polish to be worn No other visible piercings are allowed Religious or cultural accessories can only be worn in consultation with AHoS
Confiscated Jewellery	Teachers have the right to confiscate jewellery that does not meet the AIS Dress Code. It will only be returned at the end of each term. Students will need to collect this from the Secondary Secretary
Tattoos	Tattoos must be covered at all times. They are not to be visible to the school community. Students are advised not to get a tattoo during their enrolment at AIS
School Bag	Navy AIS School Bag only to be used Bags must be free from graffiti
MUFTI	Each year the school has several mufti days which often follow a theme. Regulations and themes are variable, but students are required to dress appropriately (no singlets, midriff tops, short skirts or shorts). Enclosed shoes must be worn for all practical classes
<i>*Year 12 Jersey can be worn at school. Other sports, VET, drama and hospitality branded jumpers that are related to AIS teams are NOT considered to be school uniform and should not be worn at school.</i>
