- Email the bank remittance to accounts_rec@ais.com.sg



3. Select to send via Unique Entity Number (UEN)
4. Enter 199204405H002 – Australian International School name will appear
5. Enter payment amount
6. Enter bill reference number/student full name/invoice number (up to 25 characters)
7. Confirm




3. QR CODE

2. Click on SCAN & PAY
3. Scan the PAYNOW barcode – 199204405H002- Australian International School name will appear
4. Enter payment amount
5. Enter bill reference number/student full name/invoice number (up to 25 characters)
6. Confirm



4. CREDIT CARD INFORMATION (Not Applicable for companies)

We accept Visa, Mastercard and American Express credit card payments.

5. CREDIT CARD INSTALMENT PAYMENT (Not Applicable for companies)

We also offer the credit card instalment plans offered by DBS/POSB credit cards. At the time of processing, the full amount charged (1-Semester's school fees per child) is blocked against the cardholder's credit limit but is not actually charged to the card.

The block against the credit limit decreases over the payment period as the monthly instalments are charged to the card by the Bank and paid by the card holder.

You will need to visit our Finance Office in person to process the credit card instalment payment plan (IPP).
