Position Objective

• The Laboratory Technician is a support role designed to assist the Science teachers in the preparation of equipment and materials for classes and ensuring that the environments are appropriately maintained and organised.

Responsibilities

- Preparing equipment for practical lessons in collaboration with teachers as required and in a timely manner.
- Preparing and maintaining chemicals and chemical solutions using safe practices.
- Ordering and maintaining resources including laboratory equipment, chemicals and stationery as required to ensure that stocks are as required at all times.
- Ensuring all safety equipment such as fire extinguishers are maintained and safe.
- Organising classroom and faculty displays in collaboration with and as directed by teachers.
- Ensuring laboratories are organised and tidy.
- Assisting with some classroom supervision when required.
- Organisation and collating documents such as competition entries and certificate distribution in collaboration with the Head of Department.
- Maintaining faculty files and resources collection as directed by the Head of Department.
- Liaising with external organisations to assist with the organisation of excursions.
- Completing an annual stock take of laboratory resources.
- Completing some data entry on the school administration system.
- Attending special events and excursions (as required).
- Attending Professional Development days (as required).
- Attending Secondary Staff meetings and Whole School Staff Meetings (as required).
